### **"FAST-TRACK" BACHELOR'S DEGREE IN BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION & MANAGEMENT**

*(A Program to Complete a Four-Year Management Degree)*

This is an *Accelerated Degree Completion Program (ADCP)*. Classes meet only *one* night a week. Courses are taken one at a time in sequence, and continue throughout the year without summer breaks. Students graduate in approximately half the time, and half the expense, of ordinary degrees.
