## **SUMMARY OF JWCSM's ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS, OR STUDENT QUALIFICATIONS, FOR THE BA AND MBA DEGREES**

Here are the admissions requirements for our three JWC School of Management Degrees:

### **BA DEGREE IN MANAGEMENT & BUSINESS ETHICS**

1. A high school diploma or equivalent. Home-schooled students must show proof of a high school transcript or a GED.
2. A minimum grade point average of 2.0 (on a 4.0 scale) on all prior high school and college work.
3. Official copies of high school and college transcripts.
4. A minimum of approximately 48 prior college semester-hour credits earned with a grade of "C" or better. Needed credits can also be earned through CLEP tests, Life Learning, on-the-job training, professional licenses, etc., prior to, and during enrollment.

### **MASTER'S OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION**

1. An earned bachelor's degree from a nationally or regionally accredited institution.
2. Official copies of college transcripts.

3. A minimum grade point average of 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale) on all prior college work.
4. An academic or experience background in business subjects, with an earned grade of "C" in at least one course (3 credits) in each of the following fields of study; or CLEP, Credit for Prior Learning; or other equal experience or certifications in:
  - Management
  - Communications
  - Accounting
  - Economics
  - Marketing
5. A minimum of two years of experience in some role of leadership and/or management.
6. A copy of the applicant's business resume.
7. The ability to set aside 20-30 hours per week for coursework.
8. An acceptable score on the GMAT or GRE exams, taken within the last five years. (Waived with four years of documented work experience in some role of leadership and/or management.)
9. Two letters of recommendation from business supervisors or associates.
10. An autobiographical essay of a minimum of 750 words indicating the applicant's work experience, personal goals, purpose for enrolling, and readiness for graduate-level education.
11. No transfer credits can be accepted for this accelerated program.
12. Students must own a computer with Internet access, and must have a valid permanent email address.
13. Due to the intense nature of the program, students cannot be enrolled in any other college classes or study programs while earning the MBA degree.
14. Students must maintain a 3.0 grade point average (on a 4.0 scale) during the program to maintain non-probationary status.
